## **Information about the Wastewater Treatment Plant**

The City of Willow Park's existing wastewater treatment plant is coming to the end of its life. The plant is reaching the capacity that requires the city to file plans with the Texas Commission on Environmental Control (TCEQ) for a new treatment plant.

Past efforts to address the wastewater situation failed to produce any results. In 2001, the city participated in a plan for a regional wastewater treatment plant study that never materialized into a plant. In 2006, the city started plans on a treatment plant that ended with a lawsuit. The lawsuit was finally settled in the spring of 2015. In June 2015, negotiations with the City of Weatherford for a collection based system were halted by the City of Weatherford.

The City has since identified three potential sites for a new treatment plant and is in the process of obtaining the option for the land on all three sites.

Once the City has secured the land options, a Town Hall meeting will be scheduled to discuss the technical merits, financial costs, and social pros & cons of all three sites.

From that point, the City Council will hold a meeting to select a site to proceed to the permitting process. The permitting process will then require a series of site and impact analysis that will likely take over a year to complete.
