

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE
28, REVISED CIVIL STATUTES OF TEXAS, RELATING TO
CITIES AND TOWNS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, heretofore, the Town of Willow Park Texas was duly and regularly incorporated under the provisions of Chapter 12, Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as A Town Village with more than 200 and less than 1,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, there are one or more manufacturing industries located within the boundaries of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, and it appearing to the Town Commission that it is desirable and would be to the benefit of the inhabitants of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, to adopt the provisions of Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, pertaining to Cities and Towns;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

1. That the Town Commission of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, does hereby officially find and determine that there are one or more manufacturing industries located within the territory embraced within the boundaries of the Town of Willow Park Texas.
2. That the Town of Willow Park, Texas, does hereby accept and adopt the provisions of Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas of 1925, and amendments there-to relating to Cities and Towns, as provided by Article 961, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas.
3. That such municipal corporation shall be known as "TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS".
4. The fact that the Town of Willow Park, Texas, is in immediate need of the relief afforded by the provisions of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity demanding that any rules requiring ordinances to be Passed at more than one separate meeting be suspended, and it is so ordained.
