

**ORDINANCE NO. 123**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR JOINT HEARINGS TO BE HELD BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Town Commission of Willow Park may hold on the final report of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Town any public hearing required to be held by said Town Commission, after publishing due notice, jointly with any public hearing required to be held by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Town provided, however, that the Town Commission shall not hold said public hearings or take action until it has received the final report of such Planning and Zoning Commission. This is in accordance with the provisions of the legislation of the State, as recorded in Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, Article 1011f.

Section 2. The fact that the Town of Willow Park, Texas, is in immediate need of a Zoning Ordinance which in turn requires the relief afforded in the provisions of this particular and prior ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity demanding that any and all rules requiring ordinances to be passed at more than one separate meeting be suspended, and that this ordinance take effect immediately upon and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
