

ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE FRANCHISE
PREVIOUSLY GRANTED TARRANT UTILITY COMPANY
FOR THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF A SEWER
SYSTEM WITHIN THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the rights and privileges of the sewer franchise granted Tarrant Utility Company in November, 1963, have not been exercised within the one-year period stipulated in Section 9 of said franchise,

and

WHEREAS, it does not now appear advantageous to the Town Commission of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, to grant to Tarrant Utility Company a renewal of said franchise,

THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF
WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the franchise previously granted by ordinance to Tarrant Utility Company by the governing body of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, in November, 1963, for the purpose of building and operating a sanitary sewer system, be formally and hereby repealed.

Section 2. The fact that it is essential to the general welfare of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, to immediately clarify the relationship between said Town and said Company creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity demanding that any and all rules requiring ordinances to be read or passed at more than one separate meeting be suspended, and that this ordinance take effect immediately upon and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
