

ORDINANCE NO. 128

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE
TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, CALLING AN
ELECTION FOR THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR SAID
TOWN.

WHEREAS, the terms of office of the present Mayor and Commissioners are about to expire,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

THAT an election be held on April 1, 1972, said date being the first Saturday in April, for the purposes of:

Electing a Mayor and two Commissioners for the Town of Willow Park, Texas, to serve until the next regular election as provided by the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas.

THAT said election shall be held at the Municipal Building on Stagecoach Trail in said Town of Willow Park, Texas, and Foy M. Burnes is hereby appointed Presiding Judge of Said election, and said Judge shall select two clerks to assist in holding said election, and one clerk shall be designated by said Judge to be the Alternate Presiding Judge. The Polling place shall be open from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.

THAT the manner of holding said election shall be governed by the general laws of the State of Texas regulating general elections, except as otherwise provided by the statutes herein referred to, and by the requirements of Article 1066c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, and only qualified voters who have resided in said Town for six (6) months preceding the date of the election shall be allowed to vote in said election.

A copy of this resolution signed by the Mayor of said Town and attested by the Town Secretary shall serve as a proper notice of said election.

The Mayor is authorized and directed to cause this notice of the election to be posted at each of three (3) public places within said Town for at least thirty (30) full days prior to the date of said election.

That the fact that it is essential to the general welfare of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, to conduct the election of officers for, the Town of Willow Park, creates an emergency and an imperative public need demanding that any and all rules requiring ordinances to be read or passed at more than one separate meeting be suspended, and that this ordinance take effect immediately upon and after its passage, and it is so ordained,
