

## **ORDINANCE NO. 138**

IN ORDER TO PROMOTE A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE ON KEEPING OF ANIMALS ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY IS SUBMITTED, PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$200.00 PER DAY FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WILLOW PARK:

### **SECTION I.**

No swine shall ever be kept upon the property nor shall any part of the property ever be used for a commercial feed lot for livestock, fowl, dogs or cats or any other fowl or animal. No dog or cat kennel. A kennel is defined as being five (5) or more mature animals and one litter of offspring.

### **SECTION II.**

No noxious or offensive activity shall be conducted or maintained upon any tract which may be or may become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

### **SECTION III.**

Any person or persons found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of such and shall be fined not more than \$200.00 per day for each day of violation.

Notice of violation to be sent by Certified Mail and official period of violation shall commence with receipt of notice.

### **SECTION IV.**

WHEREAS, immediate action is needed for the health and welfare of the City of Willow Park, this ordinance is to become effective at once. Therefore, upon passage of the ordinance by a 2/3 majority of the Council, it shall be effective from and after the date of its passage as made and provided by the Charter of the City of Willow Park
