

ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO SOUTHWESTERN GAS PIPELINE, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, LAY MAINTAIN, REMOVE, REPLACE AND REPAIR A SIX (6) INCH FIELD GAS GATHERING LINE IN A PORTION OF RIGHT OF WAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

The Town of Willow Park, Texas, Grantor, does hereby grant unto Southwestern Gas Pipeline, Inc., its successors assigns, as Assignee, the right, privilege and franchise to construct, lay, maintain, remove, replace, and repair a (6) inch field gas gathering transmission line along the South bar ditch of Ranch House Road beginning at the West of Valley View Court; thence, easterly in the South bar ditch to the intersection of Ranch House Road and Crown Road; in the North bar ditch of Ranch House Road to Spanish Oak Road; thence North in the West bar ditch of Spanish Oak Road to the Neil Estate Property

Also a four (4) inch line from the intersection of Ranch House Road and Crown Road in the East bar ditch of Crown Road to the South town limit.

SECTION II.

Subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in this Ordinance, the right, privilege and franchise hereby granted to Southwestern Gas Pipeline, Inc., its successors and assigns, should fail to use said line for Oil and Gas Operations for a period of twelve (12) months, this Ordinance, the right, privilege and franchise shall be void.

SECTION III.

Grantee shall complete installation within ninety (90) days after acceptance of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV.

Grantee to supply the Town at least two (2) copies of an engineering drawing showing as the installed location, depth, size and type of all lines and equipment within and all streets and highways within the Town boundaries, with specific reference to the right of way boundaries of said streets and highways.

SECTION V.

In the event the Grantee shall breach any of the terms and conditions of this franchise, the Town shall give written notice thereof pointing out the particular terms and conditions which have been breached.

SECTION VI.

After completion of all work granted by this permit, Southwestern Gas Pipeline, Inc., shall submit to the Board a written request for Town acknowledgement of satisfactory completion and a surety bond indemnifying the Town of Willow Park, Texas, against the cost of repairs which may become necessary for a period of two (2) years after final completion.

SECTION VII.

The fact that there now exist inadequate regulations governing the installation of pipelines under the jurisdiction of the Town of Willow Park, Texas, creates an urgency and emergency for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and requires that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from the and after its passage.

SECTION VIII.

This Ordinance was read and passed at a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Willow Park, Texas, called and held under the provisions of the City Charter thereof, held on the 26th day of December, 1977.
