

ORDINANCE NO. 142

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

On the 26th day of April, 1978, at 7:30 p.m. o'clock at the Municipal Building of the City of Willow Park, Texas, the Commissioners will hold a public hearing, giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Willow Park, Texas of the following described property, to wit:

All that certain lot, tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in Parker County, Texas contained within the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a concrete marker at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Farm Road 5 and Bankhead Road, thence in a Northerly direction beginning with the West R.O.W. line of said Farm Road 5 to its intersection with Interstate 20 to a point for corner;

Thence in an Easterly direction beginning with the South R.O.W. line of Interstate 20 to its intersection with the East R.O.W. line of County Road Culberson Dr. to a point for a corner;

Thence in a Southerly direction beginning with the East boundary line of said County road to its intersection with Bankhead Road to a point for a corner;

Thence in a westerly Direction beginning with the North boundary line of Bankhead Road to its intersection with the west boundary line of Farm Road 5 being a concrete marker at the point of beginning.

SECTION II.

The Mayor of the City of Willow Park is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory not more than twenty days or less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963; compiled as 970a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes.)

SECTION III.

The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at three several meetings be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
