

## **ORDINANCE NO. 146**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 134 PERTAINING TO THE ORDERLY RESTORATION OF PUBLIC STREETS WHERE CUTS ARE MADE, REQUIRING A PERMIT PRIOR TO DISTURBING STREETS AND ROADWAYS; STIPULATING RESTORATION STANDARDS: REQUIRING COMPLETION SCHEDULE; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

### SECTION I.

Ordinance No. 134, paragraph 1, is amended to include a \$100.00 fee requirement for issuance of street cutting permits. Said fee required prior to cutting any street, when a check for \$100.00 made payable to the City of Willow Park designating the specific address of the street cut to be made on record, the city will authorize street cutting to begin.

### SECTION II.

Ordinance No. 134, Paragraph 2, is amended, deleting sentence number two and three and adding the following: Street cut back fill to be compacted to 95% procter. A minimum of six inches (6) of cold mix asphalt be placed at street grade and feathered into existing roads so that there is no dip or hump which may be objectionable to the inspector. All work must be performed within seven (7) days from the beginning of street cut to final paving of roadway.

### SECTION III.

Upon completion of street cut and after inspection by city officials, a ninety dollar(\$90) rebate will be furnished, if specification in Section 2 has been met.

### EFFECTIVE DATE

The fact that there now exists inadequate regulations governing the restoration of streets and roadways creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of public safety and general welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the date of its passage.
