

## ORDINANCE NO. 147

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

### SECTION I.

On the 2nd day of August, 1978, at 7:30 P.M. o'clock at the Municipal Building of the City of Willow Park, Texas the Commissioners will hold a public hearing, giving all interested persons the right to appear and to be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Willow Park, Texas of the following described property to wit:

BEGINNING 1179.1 feet South 0°29' East of the Northwest corner of the J.W. Moore Survey, Abstract No. 884;

THENCE South 89°48' West 655.2 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE North 0°29' West a distance of 3789 feet more or less to a bronze marder in the South R.O.W. line of I-20 to its intersection with the West boundary line of Farm Road 5 a point for corner;

THENCE in a Southerly direction being with the West R.O.W. line of Farm Road 5 a distance of 2904 feet more or less to a concrete marker at its intersection with the North R.O.W. line of Bankhead Road a point for a corner;

THENCE in a Westerly direction being with the North boundary line of said Bankhead Road a distance of 2006 feet to its intersection with the East R.O.W. line of County Road Russell Road a point for a corner;

THENCE North 0°9' West 1008.7 feet being with the East R.O.W. line of said Russell Road to a point for a corner;

THENCE West 691.3 feet to the place of beginning.

### SECTION II.

The Mayor of the City of Willow Park is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory not more than twenty days or

less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature Regular Session, 1963; compiled as 970A, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes).

SECTION III.

The importance of this Ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at three meetings be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
