

ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE DENYING A RATE INCREASE TO TARRANT UTILITY COMPANY IN THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS.

Whereas, Tarrant Utility Company filed with the City of Willow Park a request for an increase in utility rates to be charged in the amount of approximately \$1.4 million per annum on a systemwide basis, an increase of approximately 207% and

Whereas, Willow Park, having suspended the effective date of such proposed rate increase from December 12, 1979, and having considered the same, is of the opinion and finds that an increase in rates should be denied.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

That the requested rate increase of Tarrant Utility Company is hereby denied.

SECTION II

That the action of the Commission of the City of Willow Park enacting this Ordinance constitutes on the date of its final passage, a final determination of rates for Tarrant Utility Company within the City of Willow Park in accordance with Section 43(e) of the Public Utility Regulatory Act.

SECTION III

Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall be construed now or hereafter as limiting or modifying, in any manner, the right and power of Willow Park under the law to regulate rates and charges of Tarrant Utility Company.
