

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO SOUTHWESTERN GAS PIPELINE, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, LAY, MAINTAIN, REMOVE, REPLACE AND REPAIR A FOUR AND ONE-HALF (4 1/2) INCH FIELD GAS GATHERING LINE IN A PORTION OF RIGHT OF WAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I

The City of Willow Park, Texas, Grantor, does hereby grant unto Southwestern Gas Pipeline, Inc., its successors assigns, as assignee, the right, privilege and franchise to construct, lay, maintain, remove, replace and repair a four and one-half inch field gas gathering transmission line along the North right of way of an asphalt road at its intersection of O.P. Leonard, Jr.'s property and said point also being South 13 degrees, 25 minutes West, 10 feet from the Southwest corner of Carey's Trailers, Inc. said right of easement being in the El Chico Addition South to the City of Willow Park, Parker County, Texas, also being in Abstract No. 218. (See metes and bounds attached hereto and made a part hereof.)

SECTION II.

Subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in this ordinance, the right, privilege, and franchise hereby granted to Southwestern Gas Pipeline Inc., its successors and assigns, should fail to use said line for oil and gas operations for a period of twelve months, this ordinance, the right, privilege and franchise shall be void.

SECTION III.

Grantee shall complete installation within ninety (90) days after acceptance of this ordinance.

SECTION IV.

Grantee to supply the city at least two (2) copies of an engineering drawing showing as the installed location, depth, size and type of all lines and equipment within any and all streets and highways within city boundaries, with specific reference to the right of way boundaries of said streets and highways

SECTION V.

In the event the Grantee shall breach any of the terms and conditions of this

franchise, the city shall give written notice thereof pointing out the particular terms and conditions which have been breached.

SECTION VI.

After completion of all work granted by this permit, Southwestern Gas Pipeline, Inc., shall submit to the board a written request for city acknowledgement of satisfactory completion and a surety bond indemnifying the City of Willow Park, Texas, against the cost of repairs which may become necessary for a period of two years after final completion.

SECTION VII.

The fact that there now exists inadequate regulations governing the installation of pipelines under the jurisdiction of the City of Willow Park, Texas, creates an urgency and emergency for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

SECTION VIII.

This ordinance was read, passed and approved at a special meeting of the City Council of Willow Park, Texas, called and held under the provisions of the City Charter thereof, held on the 10th day of April, 1981.
