

ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE A WATER WELL WHICH HAS BEEN DRILLED UPON LOT 14 BLOCK 2, SQUAW CREEK ESTATES WEST, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS, ACCORDING TO PLOT OF RECORD IN VOLUME 359A, PAGE 87, DEED RECORDS OF PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS, FROM WILLOW WOOD WATER WORKS, INC., TO PREVENT FUTURE WATER PROBLEMS DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS AND TO AUGMENT THE PRESENT WATER SYSTEMS SHOULD THERE BE A NEED THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate and purchase, for and on behalf of the City of Willow Park, Texas, a water well which has been drilled on Lot 14, Block 2, Squaw Creek Estates West, an addition to the City of Willow Park, Parker County, Texas, said lot being owned by the City of Willow Park, upon the terms and conditions as he deems best. He is additionally authorized to execute and all papers or instruments necessary to effect such transaction

SECTION II.

The necessity to negotiate and purchase the aforementioned water well at the earliest possible date, creates a public emergency and an imperative public necessity requiring the suspension of the Charter rule that no order or resolution shall be passed on the date of its introduction but that such ordinance or resolution shall be read at two several meetings of the City Aldermen, and the Mayor having requested the suspension of the Charter rule and that this ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction and take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, it is accordingly so ordained, this the 2nd day of September, 1982
