

## ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING A PRIOR ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A WATER WELL DRILLED UPON LOT 14, BLOCK 2, SQUAW CREEK ESTATES WEST, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS, FROM WILLOW WOOD WATER WORKS, INC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

### SECTION I.

The ordinance, titled as follows, which was approved and passed by the City Aldermen of the City of Willow Park on the 2nd day of September 1982, is hereby rescinded:

"An ordinance granting and authorizing the Mayor to purchase a water well which has been drilled upon Lot 14, Block 2, Squaw Creek Estates West, an addition to The City of Willow Park, Parker County, Texas, according to Plot of Record in Volume 359A, Page 87, Deed Records of Parker County, Texas, from Willow Wood Water Works, Inc., to prevent future water problems during emergency situations and to augment the present water systems should there be a need therefore."

### SECTION II.

The fact that The City of Willow Park, Texas, is in immediate need for this ordinance creates an emergency demanding that any and all rules requiring ordinances to be passed at more than one meeting be suspended and that this ordinance take effect immediately upon and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained, this the 11th day of October, 1982
