

ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TWO YEAR STAGGERED TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen, after the Municipal Election of April 5th, 1980, failed to adopt the necessary ordinance providing for a Two Year staggered term of office.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 1143 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended, the terms of office of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Willow Park, Texas shall be two year staggered terms of office.

SECTION II.

The Mayor and two aldermen, such aldermen to be selected by drawing lots at the first meeting of the Board of Aldermen following the general election to be held on 2 April 1983, shall hold their office for a term of two (2) years. The remaining three (3) Aldermen shall hold their offices for an initial term of one (1) year.

SECTION III.

At each general municipal election thereafter, the aldermen elected at such elections shall hold their office for a term of two (2) years and until their successors have qualified.

The fact that the City of Willow Park, Texas, is in immediate need for this ordinance creates an emergency demanding that any and all rules requiring ordinances to be passed at more than one meeting be suspended and that this ordinance take effect immediately upon and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.
