

ORDINANCE NO. 191A-84

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES OF WILLOW WOOD WATER WORKS, INC., FOR FURNISHING AND DISTRIBUTING AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF WATER TO THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS.

BE IT ORIDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

I.

The following rates and charges are hereby approved and granted to Willow Wood Water Works, Inc., its successors and assigns, in the furnishing of water to any portion of the City of Willow Park, Texas, as follows:

A. RESIDENTIAL RATES:

Minimum Charge	3/4" meter	\$13.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons
Minimum Charge	1" meter	\$18.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons
Minimum Charge	1-1/2" meter	\$23.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons
Minimum Charge	2" meter	\$33.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons

\$1.25 per 1,000 gallons for the next 48,000 gallons

\$1.90 per 1,000 gallons for all over 50,000 gallons

B. COMMERCIAL RATES:

"Commercial Rates" shall apply to any business that operates as such intending to make a profit.

Minimum Charge	3/4" meter	\$30.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons
Minimum Charge	1-1/2" meter	\$40.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons
Minimum Charge	2" meter	\$60.00 for 1st 2,000 gallons

\$1.75 per 1 000 gallons for the next 48,000 gallons

\$2.10 per 1,000 gallons for a@ over 50,000 gallons

Service Charge for Non-Payment (cut-off and reconnect) \$ 50.00

Service Charge for Customer Move-in (existing service)	\$ 25. 00
Service Charge for bad check collection	\$ 10. 00
Tie-on Charge, new service (one time charge)	\$500.00
Tie-on Charge, extension required	\$500.00 for first 50 feet and customer to pay all costs beyond 50 feet

II.

The fact that there now exists inadequate regulations governing the schedule of rates and charges of Willow Wood Water Works, Inc., creates an urgency and emergency for the immediate preservation of public areas, health, safety, and general welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the date of its passage.
