

ORDINANCE NO. 192-84

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LICENSING AND REGISTRATION FEES FOR ELECTRICIANS, PLUMBERS AND HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING COMPANIES; PROVIDING FOR AN ANNUAL RENEWAL SETTING FORTH DETERMINING THE PROCEDURES WITH RESPECT TO LICENSING AND RENEWAL; PROHIBITING THE DOING BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY WITHOUT REGISTRATION AND LICENSING; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to perform or cause to be performed electrical work upon or in structures within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, without first having applied for and obtained an electrician's license on the form and in the manner as is prescribed by the City Council.

Any person, firm or corporation, prior to initiating any electrical work within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, shall cause to be filed with the City Secretary his or its application for licensing and shall upon such application provide therein such information as the City Council may determine appropriate and proper with respect to background, experience, previous licensing, address, and other pertinent information.

In no event shall any such work be performed of an electrical nature within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, unless the person to be performing such work is previously licensed as a Master or Journeyman electrician.

There shall be issued to the applicant his license to perform electrical work within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park provided such application has been completed in all respects and a license fee of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) has been paid by the applicant to the City. There shall thereafter be charged an annual renewal fee of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) which the applicant shall pay to the City of Willow Park and which upon payment shall automatically cause his license within the City to be renewed for a period of one additional year.

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to perform or cause to be performed plumbing work upon or in structures within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, without first having applied for and obtained a plumber's license on the form and in the manner as is prescribed by the City Council.

Any person, firm or corporation, prior to initiating any plumbing work within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, shall cause to be filed with the City Secretary his or its application for licensing and shall upon such application provide therein such information as the City Council may determine appropriate and proper with respect to background, experience, previous licensing, address, and other pertinent information.

There shall be issued to the applicant his license to perform plumbing work within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park provided such application has been completed in all respects and a license fee of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) has been paid by the applicant to the City. There shall thereafter be charged an annual renewal fee of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) which the applicant shall pay to the City of Willow Park and which upon payment shall automatically cause his license within the City to be renewed for a period of one additional year.

SECTION 3.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to perform or cause to be performed service work or installation work in the field of heating and air conditioning upon or in structures within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, without first having applied for and obtained a license on the form and in the manner as is prescribed by the City Council.

Any person, firm or corporation, prior to initiating any service or installation work in the field of heating and air conditioning within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, shall cause to be filed with the City Secretary his or its application for licensing and shall upon such application provide therein such information as the City Council may determine appropriate and proper with respect to background, experience, previous licensing, address, and other pertinent information.

There shall be issued to the applicant his license to perform service work or installation work in the field of heating and air conditioning within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park provided such application has been completed in all respects and a license fee of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) has been paid by the applicant to the City. There shall thereafter be charged an annual renewal fee of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) which the applicant shall pay to the City of Willow Park and which upon payment shall automatically cause his license within the City to be renewed for a period of one additional year.

SECTION 4.

Except as amended herein, all previous ordinances not inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

Any person, firm or corporation that violates, disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with, or that resists the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), nor more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such. The City of Willow Park may also bring suit for injunction against any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or threaten to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance in order to prevent a continued violation of such threatened violation.

SECTION 6.

Severability clause: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its publication as required by law.
