

ORDINANCE NO. 196-85

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE ELECTED OFFICE OF THE MARSHAL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTED OFFICE OF THE MARSHAL WITH SUCH ASSISTANTS IS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS

BE IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

1.

Acting pursuant to Art. 99A, of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, Chapter, 3, of Title 28, the elected office of City Marshal for the City of Willow Park, Texas, is abolished.

2.

The Board of Aldermen shall be authorized to appoint a City Marshal to serve as the law enforcement officer for the City of Willow Park upon such conditions, and for such tenure as is in the best judgement of the Board of Alderman. In keeping with the same, the Board of Aldermen shall also be entitled to select and appoint such assistants to aid and assist the City Marshal of the City of Willow Park in the performance of his duties as may be deemed appropriate at any given time.

3.

All previous rights, functions, obligation, and duties attendant to the elected Office of City Marshal are hereby transferred and conveyed over to the person occupying the appointed position of City Marshal for the City of Willow Park, Texas.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage as provided by law.
