

ORDINANCE NO. 198-85

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR STREET AND STORM DRAIN CONSTRUCTION CURRENTLY IN USE BY THE CITY OF FORT WORTH AND AS HEREINAFTER AMENDED; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 119A-84 TO THE EXTENT OF CONFLICTS; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1

The City of Willow Park, by this ordinance, does hereby adopt the standard specifications for street and storm drain construction adopted by the City of Fort Worth and currently in use to the end that such specifications shall, after adoption of this ordinance, be those to be used by the City of Willow Park. Moreover, by this ordinance, the City of Willow Park does likewise adopt any and all future amendments, alterations and changes as may be effectuated by the City of Fort Worth in the same said standard specifications. A copy of such specifications is hereby attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference as fully as though copied verbatim herein.

SECTION 2

All previous ordinances, including Ordinance No. 119A-84, are to the extent of any conflict with this ordinance repealed.

SECTION 3

Should any part, portion, section or subsection of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way affect the remaining portions, parts, sections or subsections of this ordinance, which provisions shall be, remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4

Any person, firm or corporation that violates, disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with, or that resists the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such. The City of Willow Park may also bring suit for injunction against any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or threaten to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance in order to prevent a continued

violation of such threatened violation.

SECTION 5

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
