

ORDINANCE NO. 201-85

AN ORDINANCE DECREEEING AN EMERGENCY AND IMPOSING
A MORATORIUM ON THE DRILLING OF ANY WATER WELLS
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILLOW
PARK UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 1985

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW
PARK, TEXAS:

I.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, save and except the City of Willow Park, to drill or cause to be drilled a water well within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, between the date of the passage of this ordinance and October 1, 1985.

II.

Should any part, portion, section or subsection of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way affect the remaining portions, parts, sections or subsections of this ordinance, which provisions shall be, remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

III.

Any person, firm or corporation that violates, disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with, or that resists the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less that Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such. The City of Willow Park may also bring suit for injunction against any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or threaten to violate any of the provisions of the ordinance in order to prevent a continued violation of such threatened violation.

IV.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
