

ORDINANCE NO. 232-87

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO THE WILLOW PARK FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, The Willow Park Fire Department provides emergency fire and medical services to the citizens of the City of Willow Park; and,

WHEREAS, Such Fire Department is a voluntary organization in need of financial support; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council has determined that the citizens of the City of Willow Park are desirous of supporting same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

Sec. 1. THAT the City of Willow Park institute a voluntary program of contributions to the Willow Park Fire Department by establishing on any billings for City services, whether it be water, garbage, etc. an appropriate space and allowance for the citizens of Willow Park to make a donation to the payment of these city services to the Willow Park Fire Department.

Sec. 2. The City, by this Ordinance, hereby places upon the city service bills, the recommended voluntary contribution of \$1.00 per month. That same shall be part of the bill as soon as may be appropriately done through modification of the billing process to denote a voluntary contribution to the Willow Park Fire Department.

Prior to the instigation of such voluntary contributions, each citizen be notified in an appropriate manner so as to alert and inform them that such voluntary contribution will be placed on their bills for city services. That same is voluntary and at all times will remain voluntary. Further, that the bill for city services should always carry the designation of voluntary contribution in bold and conspicuous manner.

All funds so received shall be collected by the

City Secretary and paid to the order of Willow Park Fire Department at intervals determined by the City Administrator so as to not interfere with the City's normal financial procedures.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
