

ORDINANCE NO. 252-89

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 241-88 THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET; AND 242-88 THE UTILITY FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1988-89; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL OPERATING REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES; PROVIDING FOR A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND NAMING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City Council under the Laws of the State of Texas to approve a fiscal budget for the operation of City Government in providing services and community development; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing for citizen participation has been conducted for consideration of the proposed budget amendment for Fiscal Year 1988-89;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I

SECTION 1.01. ADOPTION OF FISCAL BUDGET AMENDMENT

The Fiscal Year Operating Budget for FY 1988-89 for the General Fund and the Utility Fund is hereby amended and approved the same as though such document originally contained these requirements: To wit see attached Exhibit "A" listing budget amendments which is incorporated herein by reference as if stated herein verbatim.

ARTICLE II

SECTION 2.01. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

The provisions of the Fiscal Budget of the General Fund and the Utility Fund for 1988-89 are declared severable, and if any section or provision shall for any reason be held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections or provisions, but they shall remain in effect, it being the intent that the Fiscal Budget for 1988-89 shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

ARTICLE III

SECTION 3.01. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

PRESENTED AND GIVEN first and final reading the 8th day of August, 1989, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Willow Park, Texas, by a vote of 3 ayes and 0 nays.

Council Member Harrell moved to amend the FY 88-89 General Fund Budget to provide \$12,000. for road repairs, \$20,000. for engineering bills, and \$6,000. for engineering bills in the Enterprise fund budget; seconded by Council Member Noe; all voted in the affirmative; the motion carried.

B. APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR 1989-90, CITY ADMINISTRATOR.

Council Member Harrell moved to approve the ordinance levying ad valorem tax rate of .1647 on each \$100.00 valuation for FY 89-90 budget; seconded by Council Member Noe; all voted in the affirmative; the motion carried.
