

## **ORDINANCE NO. 258-89**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 253-89 LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, FOR THE 1989 - 1990 FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BUDGET AS AFFECTED THEREBY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK:

- Sec. 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected to provide an Interest and Sinking Fund for the 1989 - 1990 fiscal year, upon all property, real, personal and, mixed, within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas subject to taxation, a tax of .1147 on each \$100 valuation of property, such .1147 rate to become effective immediately upon the conclusion of the public hearing as hereinafter provided for.
- Sec. 2. That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 1989, if not paid on or before January 31, 1990, shall immediately become delinquent.
- Sec. 3. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the Parker County Tax Authority is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and of the City of Willow Park shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real, or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the interest and penalty collected from such delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.
- Sec. 4. A public hearing shall be held on the budget as effected by the tax rate remaining at the 1988-89 fiscal Year level.
- Sec. 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.

Passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Willow Park, Texas, this the 19th day of September, 1989, by a vote of 5 to 0.
