

ORDINANCE NO. 264-89

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE REMOVAL, DESTRUCTION OR DISCOLORATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND/OR STREET SIGNS OR OTHER SIGNS DIRECTED BY THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be it ordained by the City of Willow Park.

I.

It shall be unlawful to alter, remove, mark upon, deface or otherwise discolor any traffic control sign, street sign or other signs erected by the city of Willow Park within its corporate limits.

II.

Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by a competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

III.

Any person, firm or corporation that violates, disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with, or that resists the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) nor more than TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200. 00) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

The City may also bring suit for injunction against any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or threaten to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, in order to prevent a continued violation of such threatened violation.

IV.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
