

**ORDINANCE NO. 376-95**

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK WATER/WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1995 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1996; APPROPRIATING MONEY TO A SINKING FUND TO PAY INTEREST AND PRINCIPAL DUE ON THE WATER/WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT INDEBTEDNESS; AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK WATER/WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995-96.**

WHEREAS, the budget, appended here, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1995 and ending September 30, 1996, was duly presented to the City Council and a public notice of said hearing was caused to be given by the City Council and said notice was published in the newspaper and said public hearing was held according to said notice;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1995 and ending September 30, 1996, for the support of the Water/Wastewater Department of the City of Willow Park, Texas, be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with expenditures shown in the Water/Wastewater Department's fiscal year 1995-1996 budget.

Section 2. That the budget is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the Water/Wastewater Department's budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1995 and ending September 30, 1996.

Section 3. That there is hereby appropriated the amount shown in said budget necessary to provide for a sinking fund for the payment of the principal, interest, and retirement of the bonded debt of the City of Willow Park Water/Wastewater Department.

**AND IT IS SO ORDERED.**
