

ORDINANCE NO. 377-95

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK FOR THE 1995-1996 FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected to provide an Interest and Sinking Fund for the 1995-1996 fiscal year, and all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of the City of Willow Park, Texas, subject to taxation, a tax of .1059 on each \$100 valuation of property.

Section 2. That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 1995, if not paid on or before January 31, 1996, shall immediately become delinquent.

Section 3. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the Parker County Tax Authority is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Willow Park shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the interest and penalty collected from each delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
