

ORDINANCE NO. 415-97

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS HAS DETERMINED THE NEED TO CLARIFY THE INTENT OF THE CITY TO OPERATE THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM AS SEPARATE SYSTEMS WITH SEPARATE FINANCIAL OPERATIONS. THE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY AMENDS CHAPTER 11 PUBLIC UTILITIES OF THE WILLOW PARK CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCLUDE ARTICLE 11.100A, TITLED "PUBLIC UTILITIES ORGANIZATION STATEMENT." ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 11 SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AS PREVIOUSLY WRITTEN AND ADOPTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

(1) The following Article is being added to Chapter I 1, and shall read as follows. All other provisions of Chapter I 1, shall remain in full force as previously written and adopted.

(2) Chapter 11, Article 11.100A

PUBLIC UTILITIES ORGANIZATION STATEMENT:

The City of Willow Park operates Public Utilities consisting of a Waterworks System and a Sanitary Sewer System. The Waterworks System and Sanitary Sewer System are operationally and financially two separate and distinct systems, with their own distinctive rules, regulations, duties, obligations, and finances.

AND IT IS SO- ORDERED.
