ORDINANCE NO. 421-98

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1.1100(a)(1) OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, TO DESIGNATE THE COMMUNITY NEWS OF PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALER

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, is required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code (1998) after the beginning of each municipal year to determine and designate an official newspaper of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park has determined by inquiry and due diligence that the *Community News* is a newspaper of general circulation that is delivered to and includes subscribers in the City of Willow Park, contains news items of general interest concerning the City of Willow Park and otherwise qualifies as an official newspaper.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor, or his designees is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provision of this Ordinance by contract(s).

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT

Chapter 1, Article 1.1100 OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER, Subparagraph (a)(1) shall be amended to read as follows:

"*The Community News* of Parker County, Texas (132 E. Oak, Aledo, TX 76008) is designated as the official newspaper of the City of Willow Park, Texas. The City shall cause to be published in the official newspaper each ordinance, notice or other matter required by law or ordinance to be published"

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and Ordinance No. 339-93, passed and approved by the City Council on June 23, 1993 is particularly repealed; and, Ordinance No. 419-98 passed and approved by the City Council on April 21, 1998 is also particularly repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
