

ORDINANCE NO. 429-98

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK FOR THE 1998 TAX YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park has followed the procedure established by the Property Tax Code, including the publishing and posting of required notices and the holding of required public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved separately each of the two components of the tax rate hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: That there shall be and there is hereby levied the following taxes on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation on all taxable property within the City of Willow Park, Texas, to be assessed and collected for the year 1998 for the purposes hereinafter stipulated, to wit:

- (a) For the General Fund (maintenance and operation) levied on each \$100.00 valuation; .0754 and
- (b) For the interest and sinking fund levied on each \$100.00 valuation; .0446 for a

Total of .1200 on each \$100.00 valuation.

Section 2: That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 1998, if not paid on or before January 31, 1999, shall become delinquent.

Section 3: All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed and the Parker County Tax Authority is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Willow Park shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the penalty and interest collected from such delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED
