ORDINANCE NO. 431-98

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPDENDIX A, ARTICLE 15.000, RATE SCHEDULE FOR WATER SERVICE, SUBPARAGRAPHS (b) AND (e) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALER.

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park wishes to provide for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to furnish water service; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to create, provide and maintain waterwork facilities that are safe, adequate, efficient and reasonable for the provision of said service(s); and

WHEREAS, the City will ascertain and fix just and reasonable standards, classifications, regulations, service rules, service standards and practices to be observed in the furnishing of water; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges and recognizes that the provision of adequate, efficient, reasonable and safe waterwork services to those outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Willow Park depend on: sufficiency of supply, age of delivery system, facility, capacity of the system, pressure within the system, remoteness of the extra-territorial customer and other objective and physical differences; a reasonable basis for different rates and classifications of residential and non-residential customers and customers outside the corporate limits of the municipality is created.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor, or appropriate City Official or Mayor's designee is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. APPLICATIONS

The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all persons, customers and property served by the City of Willow Park waterworks, wherever situated. No

customer of the City of Willow Park Water System shall knowingly make, cause, use or permit the use of water received from the City for residential, commercial, industrial, governmental or any other purpose in a manner contrary to any provision of this or other previously enacted ordinances, or in the amount in excess that use permitted by the conservation stage in effect pursuant to action taken by the Mayor in accordance with the provisions of this or other ordinances.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT

Appendix A, Article 15.000, Rate Schedule for Water Service, Subparagraph (b)(2) is amended as follows:

(2) Municipal Rates:

- (a) Residential. Water sold by the City waterworks to residential customers within the corporate municipal boundaries, shall be a purchase price of usage based on consumption per 1,000 gallons per month as shown below:

0-16,000	gallons	\$1.85
16,001 - 22,000	gallons	\$2.00
22,001 - 30,000	gallons	\$2.25
30,001 - 40,000	gallons	\$2.50
40,001 - 50,000	gallons	\$2.75
50,001 - 75,000	gallons	\$3.70
75,001 +	gallons	\$5.00

(b) Commercial

1. For water sold by the City waterworks to non-residential customers inside the municipal corporate boundaries, they shall be charged a monthly base rate according to the chart below for each meter or meters connected directly or indirectly to the water system of the City, regardless of usage:

5/8" meter	\$22.86/monthly
3/4" meter	\$40.56/monthly

1" meter	\$58.26/monthly
1 1/2" meter	\$87.39/monthly
2" meter	\$186.44/monthly
4" meter	\$391.96/monthly
6" meter	\$578.40/monthly
8" meter	\$800.00/monthly

rate they shall be charged a purchase price of usage of \$2.75 per 1,000 gallons water consumed per month.

- In addition to the monthly base rate they shall be charged a purchase price of usage of \$1.85 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed per month.

(3) Rates Outside Municipal Boundary:

- Residential. Water sold by the City waterworks to residential customers outside the corporate municipal boundaries, shall be a purchase price of usage based on consumption per 1,000 gallons per month as shown below:

0-16,000 gallons	\$2.75
16,001 - 22,000 gallons	\$2.90
22,001 - 30,000 gallons	\$3.15
30,001 - 40,000 gallons	\$3.40
40,001 - 50,000 gallons	\$3.65
50,001 - 75,000 gallons	\$4.60
75,001 + gallons	\$5.90

- Non-Residential,

- For water sold by the City to non-residential customers for use outside the municipal corporate boundaries they shall be charged after a base rate according to the chart below for each meter or meters connected directly or indirectly to the water system of the City regardless of usage:

5/8" meter	\$34.29/monthly
3/4" meter	\$60.84/monthly
1" meter	\$87.39/monthly
2" meter	\$279.66/monthly
4" meter	\$587.94/monthly

- In addition to the monthly base

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and, Art. 15.000(d)(2) of Ordinance No. 358-94, as passed and approved by the City Council on March 15, 1994 is particularly repealed.

SECTIONS. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication one time in the official publication of the City of Willow Park, Texas which publication shall contain the captions stating in substance the purpose of the ordinance and reciting the penalty provision of the ordinance.
