

**CITY OF WILLOW PARK**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 440 - 99**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE  
CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE FROM WILLOW PARK  
CABLE T.V. LIMITED PARTNERSHIP TO MALLARD  
CABLEVISION, L.L.C. ; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE,  
REPEALER AND PUBLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willow Park granted a cable television franchise in Ordinance No. 172; and

**WHEREAS**, Willow Park Cable T.V. Limited Partnership is the successor in interest to said franchise; and

**WHEREAS**, Willow Park Cable T.V. Limited Partnership has entered into an agreement to sell its assets, including the franchise, to Mallard Cablevision, L.L.C.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT  
ORDAINED BY THE CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:**

1. The City of Willow Park, Texas authorizes the transfer of the franchise from Willow Park Cable T.V. Limited Partnership to Mallard Cablevision, L.L.C., with right to assign such franchise as security interest, should such be required by financial resources to Mallard Cablevision, L.L.C.
2. The City of Willow Park, Texas declares that Willow Park Cable T.V. Limited Partnership is currently in material compliance

with all of the terms and conditions of the franchise.

3. The consent to transfer shall be effective only upon the closing of the sale of assets between Willow Park Cable T.V. Limited Partnership and Mallard Cablevision, L.L.C.
