## ORDINANCE NO. 462 - 00

### AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK FOR THE 2000 TAX YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park has followed the procedure established by the Texas Tax Code, including the publishing and posting of required notices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved separately each of the two components of the tax rate hereinafter set forth;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS THAT:**

**Section 1:** That there shall be and there is hereby levied the following taxes on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation on all taxable property within the City of Willow Park, Texas, to be assessed and collected for tax year 2000, for the purposes hereinafter stipulated, to wit:

- (a) For the General Fund (maintenance and operation) there is levied on each \$100.00 valuation a tax rate of \$.12; and,
- (b) For the interest and sinking fund (debt service) there is levied on each \$100.00 valuation a tax rate of \$.00; and,

- (c) Resulting in a combined tax levy of \$.12 on each \$100.00 valuation.

**Section 2:** That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 2000; and, if not paid on or before January 31, 2001, shall be delinquent.

**Section 3:** All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which they are assessed and the Parker County Tax Authority is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Willow Park and shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest; and, the penalty and interest collected from such delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate prescribed by state law.

**Section 4:** That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.
