ORDINANCE NO. 549-06

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CITY OF WILLOW PARK ORDINANCE NO. 548-06, ADOPTED THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY 2006, PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, TX is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Willow Park to protect the health, safety and welfare and well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 548-06 on February 21, 2006, and by said ordinance did order and call an election within the City and provide for the appointment of election judges; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into an agreement with Parker County for the provision of election services, and said agreement provides for an election judge; and

WHEREAS, §32.005 TEX. ELECTION CODE provides for the manner of appointment of a presiding election judge and an alternate presiding judge for the election so designated and ordered.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION

All of the above precatory statements are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 548-06 is hereby by amended by the deletion of the entirety of Section 5. ELECTION JUDGES, to be replaced as follows:

The Willow Park City Council in acting on Ordinance No. 549-06 did on the 21st day of March, 2006, vote as follows:

SECTION 5. ELECTION JUDGES

Election Judges shall be selected, notified and compensated by the County.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its adoption.
