ORDINANCE NO. 587-08

AN ORDINANCE DENYING THE PROPOSED CHANGE IN RATES FOR ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY LLC; AND, DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, Texas (City) is a general law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is intent of the City of Willow Park to protect the health, safety and welfare and well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the municipal offices of the City perform certain functions related to the preservation of order, health, prosperity and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 27, 2008, Oncor Electric Delivery Company (Oncor), pursuant to The Public Utilities Regulatory Act (PURA) §§ 33.001 and 36.001 filed with the City of Willow Park, Texas a Statement of Intent to increase electric transmission and distribution rates by \$275 million in all municipalities exercising original jurisdiction within its service area effective August 8, 2008; and

WHEREAS, PURA § 36.108 grants local regulatory authorities the right to suspend the effective date of proposed rate changes for ninety (90) days after the date the rate change would otherwise be effective; and

WHEREAS, PURA § 33.023 provides that costs incurred by Cities in ratemaking activities are to be reimbursed by the regulated utility; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City did adopt Resolution No. 08-08 on July 21, 2008 suspending the proposed effective date of the Oncor Electric and Delivery Company, LLC rate increase for a period of ninety (90) days.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK THAT:

SECTION 1. RATE DENIAL

That the proposed change in rates filed with the Governing Body of this municipality by Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC on June 27, 2008, are hereby denied and disapproved, and Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC shall continue to provide electric delivery service within this municipality in accordance with its rate schedules and service regulations in effect within this municipality on June 27, 2008,.

SECTION 2. NOTICE

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed is open to the public and as required by law and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of the passage and approval hereof.
