ORDINANCE NO. 600-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1.1000 "DEPOSITORY" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS, TO DESIGNATE THE COMPASS BANK, N.A., AS THE OFFICIAL DEPOSITORY OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALER

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, is a municipal corporation duly and legally formed in the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City is a general law municipality with specific powers delegated to it to protect the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, is authorized by Chapter 105 of the TEX. LOCAL GOVT. CODE to enter into a depository services contract with a commercial depository for the receipt and disbursement of municipal funds or any department or agency thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park has complied with the procedural requirements as set forth by Chapter 105, TEX. LOCAL GOVT. CODE and has designated as the municipal depository "Compass Bank, N.A." (5171 East I-20, Service Road North, Willow Park, Texas 76087).

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. DESIGNATED OFFICER

Pursuant to §105.001 TEX. LOCAL GOVT. CODE, the governing body of the municipality does hereby name as designated officers the incumbent of the following offices:

Mayor
Mayor Pro-Tem
City Administrator
City Secretary

The designated officer is delegated the authority for payment of funds from the depository account pursuant §105.074, TEX. LOCAL GOVT. CODE except that the designated officer may not solely authorize the withdrawal of funds.

SECTION 3. NOTICE

The City Secretary is hereby ordered to provide notice of this action, by providing an executed copy of the Ordinance, to Compass Bank, N.A.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby only repealed to the extent of any such conflict; Chapter 1, Section 11, of the Code of 1986, as passed by the City Council on June 23, 1993; and, Ordinance 425-98 as passed by the City Council on September 15, 1998; and Ordinance 505-03 as passed by the City Council on December 16, 2003; and Ordinance 561-07 as passed by the City Council on June 19, 2007 are particularly repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 6. RECITALS

The City Council hereby finds and declares all precatory language herein to be true and correct and approves and adopts the same herein as part of this Resolution.
