

# CITY OF WILLOW PARK

## ORDINANCE NO. 622-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, "TRAFFIC CONTROL", SCHEDULE A, "TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE LISTING", BY ADDING A TEMPORARY DIRECTIONAL SIGN IN AND ON A DESIGNATED LOCAL STREET; PROVIDING A PENALTY; A REPEALER; AND, AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is intent of the City of Willow Park to protect the health, safety and welfare and well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter 10, "Traffic Control", Section 10.207, CODE OF ORDINANCES, the City is empowered to install or erect temporary traffic control devices to protect the public under certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the construction, rehabilitation or reconstruction of Stagecoach Trail ("Stagecoach") from the westbound frontage roads of Interstate Highway 20, north to the intersection of Stagecoach with Ranch House Road is an ongoing road construction project within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Stagecoach construction project requires the debriding and removal of the existing paved road surface sequentially in each lane of traffic and the provision of police, fire and emergency medical service ("EMS") requires one lane to be passable at all times; and

WHEREAS, to preserve the public safety, orderly vehicular travel and police, fire and EMS, it is necessary to direct traffic temporarily only in a one way direction southbound from Ranch House Road south on Stagecoach to the intersection with westbound service roads for Interstate Highway 20; and

WHEREAS, the one way traffic direction is temporary due to the ongoing construction or reconstruction of Stagecoach and will be returned to two lane traffic at the completion of the construction.

WHEREAS, temporary signage to display the one way direction to the residents, general public and vehicular traffic will be placed in accordance with Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:**

### SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor, or his assignee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this ordinance as relates to the enforcement of the speed zones contained herein, within the municipal boundaries of the City of Willow Park, Texas.

### SECTION 2. AMENDMENT

Chapter 10, "Traffic Control"; Schedule A, "Traffic Control Device Listing" is amended to add the following:

Stagecoach Trail One Way 100-300 Block of Stagecoach Trail Direction to be traveled north to south

### SECTION 3. DESIGNATION AND SIGNAGE

Stagecoach Trail is a roadway within the corporate limits of the City and under the jurisdiction of the City Council for designating one way traffic. Stagecoach Trail pursuant to the amendment herein to Chapter 10, Schedule A is hereby designated one way and the City shall erect appropriate signs giving notice of the designation created on the roadway so designated and when said signs are erected for one way traffic an operator shall drive only in the direction indicated by the signage.

### SECTION 4. RECITALS

The City Council hereby finds and declares all precatory language herein to be true and correct and approves and adopts the same herein as part of this Resolution.

### SECTION 5. PENALTY

A violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more

\$200.00 upon conviction.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 7. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective on or after its publication in a newspaper of general publication stating its purpose and penalty.


