ORDINANCE NO. 684-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF MUNICIPAL WATER CONSERVATION PLAN AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, Texas ("City") is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City is a general law municipality with specific powers delegated to it to protect the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Willow Park, to provide for the public health, safety and general welfare of citizens and their property; and

WHEREAS, the provision of adequate water resources to the citizens is necessary for health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, in conditions of drought, certain measures must be put in place to preserve the water resources and to assure the water resources maximum beneficial use and that waste or unreasonable use should be prevented; and

WHEREAS, to further conservation of water the City will establish a Water Conservation Plan to establish certain goals, plans and strategies to conserve use, reduce loss, improve delivery and providing ongoing public education.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor or appropriate City Official or Mayor's designee is hereby appointed and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. WATER CONSERVATION PLAN

The Water Conservation Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein for all purposes, is hereby adopted in and for the City and the customer's of the municipal water works system.

SECTION 3. RECITALS

The City Council hereby finds and declares all precatory language herein to be true and correct and approves and adopts the same herein as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication one time in the official publication of the City of Willow Park, Texas which publication shall contain the captions stating in substance the purpose of the ordinance and reciting the penalty provision of the ordinance.
