

CITY OF WILLOW PARK

ORDINANCE NO. 723-15

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION TO AMEND CHAPTER 10, "TRAFFIC CONTROL", SCHEDULE "A" OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND, AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, TX is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Willow Park to protect the health, safety and welfare and well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City, under powers delegated to it, pursuant to Chapter 51, TEX. LOCAL GOV'T CODE, has the authority to regulate traffic on its streets for the purpose of protecting public welfare and safety; and

WHEREAS, Article 10.204(a) "INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" Municipal Code of Ordinances, provides that the City Council has the authority to adopt the location of traffic control signs, signals and markings within the jurisdiction of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the location of traffic control signs, signals and markings is described in "ATTACHMENT A", Chapter 10 "TRAFFIC CONTROL", Municipal Code of Ordinances and from time to time requires modification; and,

WHEREAS, with the completion of the Stagecoach Estates subdivision within the City and the resultant vehicular traffic on the interior residential streets, certain traffic control devices are necessary for the safety and protection of residents and traffic.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT

Chapter 10 "TRAFFIC CONTROL" SCHEDULE "A", is amended by adding to Traffic Control Devices, designated "Stop Signs", as follows:

"Street Location Intersecting Street Traffic Direction

<u>Pony Express Trail</u>	<u>Carnage Drive</u>	<u>North Bound</u>
<u>Single Tree Lane</u>	<u>Overland Trail</u>	<u>West Bound</u>
<u>Single Tree Lane</u>	<u>Carnage Drive</u>	<u>East Bound</u>
<u>Spoke Trail</u>	<u>Overland Trail</u>	<u>West Bound</u>
<u>Wagonwheel Road</u>	<u>Overland Trail</u>	<u>North Bound</u>
<u>Wagonwheel Road</u>	<u>Single Tree Lane</u>	<u>South Bound</u>

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Resolution or Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 4. REPEALER.

To the extent any other Ordinance or Resolution is inconsistent with the provisions herein it is hereby repealed and superseded by the provisions herein.

SECTION 5. RECITALS.

The City Council hereby finds and declares all precatory language herein to be true and correct and approves and adopts the same herein as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. PUBLICATION

The City Secretary is hereby directed to publish the caption of this Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation.
