



VANDALISM IN YOUR AREA

21 reports of criminal mischief in Willow Park

Numerous criminal mischief cases have been reported to the Willow Park and Weatherford Police Departments. A myriad of victims found their vehicle windows shattered from what appeared to be a BB or pellet gun. The police department has received 21 reports regarding the identical but random damage. Most of the offenses occurred in the Stagecoach Estates, Hunters Glen, and North Chase subdivisions in Willow Park and in the East and West Lake area, in addition to the Lake Hills housing addition in Weatherford. Detectives have also learned that approximately two dozen similar cases have been reported to the Parker County Sheriff's Office from around the Aledo area and three at the Park-and-Ride on Interstate 20 in East Parker County.

The Police Departments are requesting the public's assistance to help solve these cases. Parker County Crime Stoppers is offering a reward of \$2,500 for any information leading to the arrest or indictment of the suspect(s). If you have any information that could help us solve these cases, please contact 817-599-5555. Callers may provide information anonymously.

All Departments are working together to solve this issue and ask that those with any information or who see anything suspicious to call their local law enforcement.
