RESOLUTION NO. 06-13

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PURCHASING COOPERATIVE; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Willow Park, Texas (City) is a general law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is intent of the City of Willow Park to protect the health, safety and welfare and well being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the municipal offices of the City perform certain functions related to the preservation of order, health, prosperity and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 791, TEX. GOV'T CODE, the City is a "local government" and "political subdivision" that is an eligible entity under the Interlocal Cooperation Act and possesses adequate legal authority to enter into contracts; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition and acquiring of equipment and vehicles for the use by police departments is a governmental function that each party to the contract is authorized to perform individually; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Purchasing Cooperative is further authorized as a local purchasing cooperative organization as set forth in Section 271.101, et seq., of the TEX. LOCAL GOV'T CODE; and

WHEREAS, Local Government Purchasing Cooperative has instituted a cooperative purchasing program under which it may

contract with other local governments or political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §271.101, TEX. LOCAL GOV'T CODE, the City may agree with a Local Government Purchasing Cooperative to purchase certain goods and services; and

WHEREAS, such an agreement between the City and the Local Government Purchasing Cooperative satisfies the requirements to seek competitive bids for the purchase of the goods and services pursuant to §791.025, id.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOW PARK THAT:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION.

The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. CONTRACT AUTHORIZATION.

The governing body of the City does hereby authorize the Mayor or Mayor's designee to execute an Interlocal Contract for Cooperative Purchasing, attached hereto as Exhibit A, or a similar contract not materially different, if approved by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, it shall not affect any valid provisions of this or any other Ordinance of the City of Willow Park to which these rules and regulations relate.

SECTION 4. REPEALER.

To the extent any other ordinance or resolution is inconsistent with the provisions herein it is hereby repealed and superseded by the provisions herein.

SECTION 5. RECITALS.

The City Council hereby finds and declares all precatory language herein to be true and correct and approves and adopts the same herein as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.
